

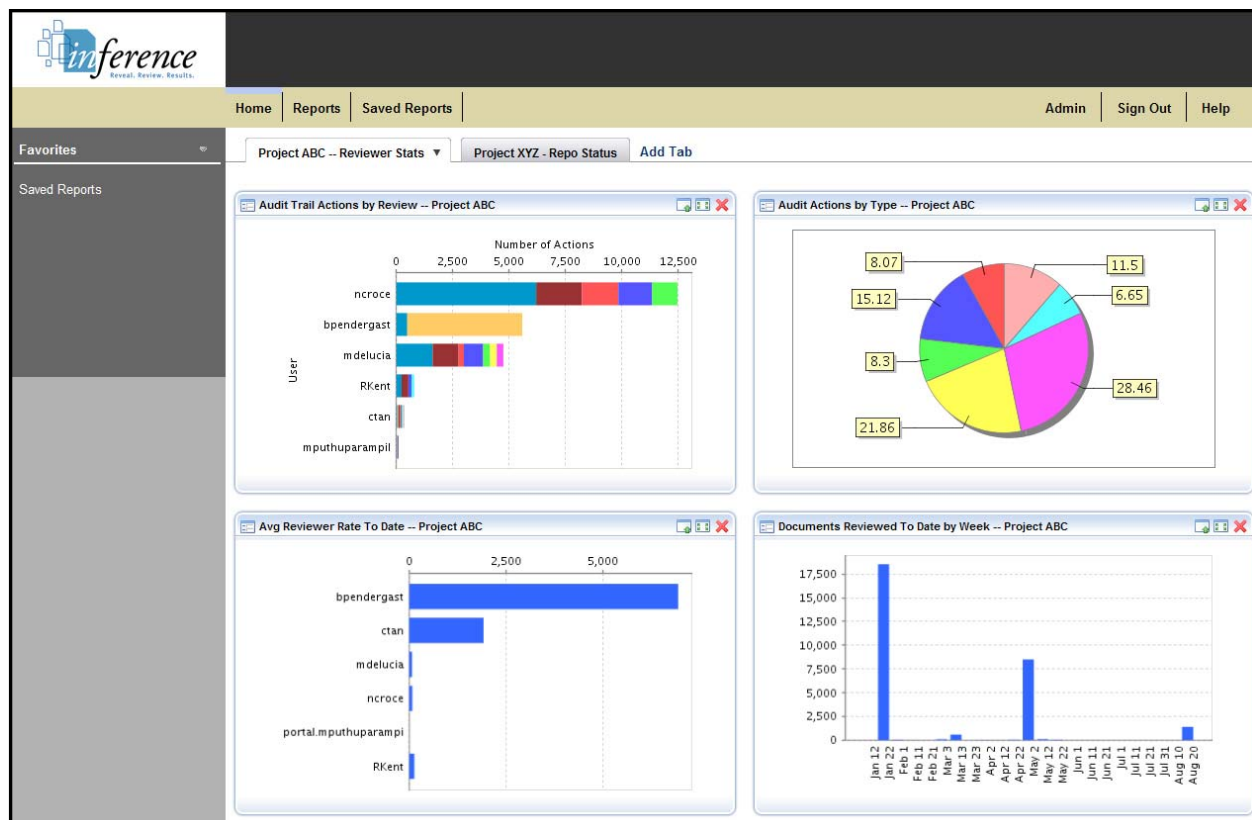
# REPORTING PORTAL

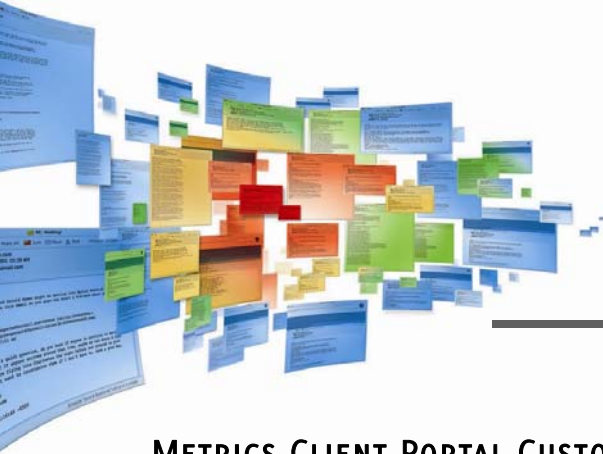

From Metrics, administrators can customize an array of report types to manage progress, improve efficiencies, and target and deploy resources. From a central, customizable dashboard, users will be able to select from a range of reporting options, and further configure reports for individual matters or groups of matters in a variety of formats including line, bar, pie and audit trail reporting. Custom reporting includes:

**Timeline Reports.** Metrics' Timeline Reports offer critical insight into the progress of a review. Administrators can select from a variety of different reports to view actions, reviewers and progress across a repository.



**Detailed Statistics.** Metrics' Statistics Reporting options provide administrators with information and statistics focused on issues and relevance, as well as analysis into the percentages of domains, custodians, date ranges and other crucial information relevant to a case.



**Issues Analysis.** Metrics' Issues Analysis reports provide comprehensive information regarding the breakdown and makeup of the document population as it relates to the key issues and areas of a case.



**Reviewer Reporting.** Metrics' Reviewer Reporting provides administrators with an in-depth view into the status of a project by analyzing the efficiency of workflow and review rates by individual reviewers as well as teams.
